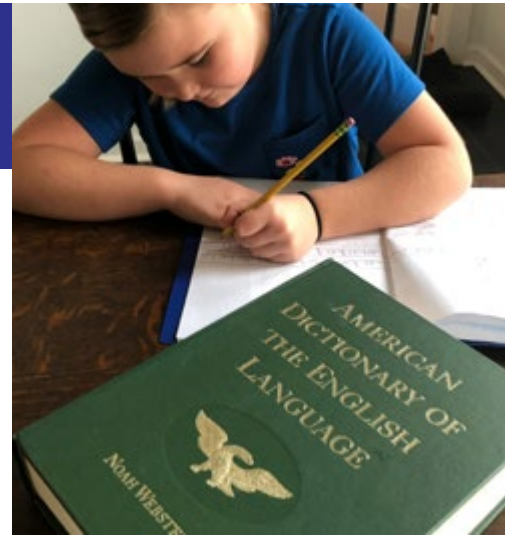

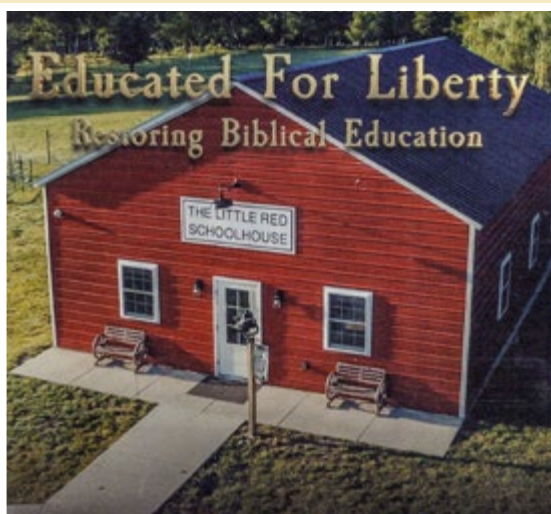
WHY YOU NEED THE 1828 AMERICAN DICTIONARY

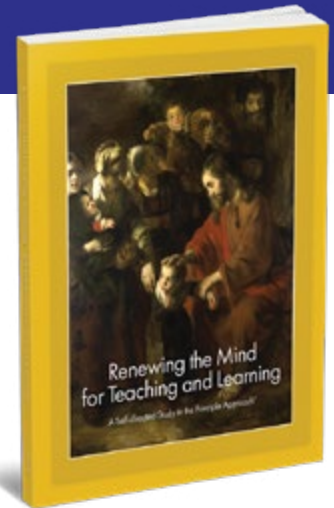
MUST-SEE NEW MOVIE

TEACHING, INSPIRING, AND LEADING HER CHILDREN

The Principle Approach applies to every area of life and every subject. Dr. Kimberly Bebb discovered this when she and her husband, Dr. Greg Bebb, chose to homeschool their six children. While they enjoyed studying theology and applying a Biblical worldview to their daily lives, they began asking an important question: how could that same worldview shape the way their children were educated?

They discovered the Principle Approach, a method of education that informed all of life. “We learned to ask the question, ‘Who or what is in control?’” Kim explained.

“That question applies to every sphere of life—the home, the church, and civil government.”

Kim soon realized that Biblical thinking cannot simply be added to education by attaching a Bible verse to a subject. Instead, it must shape a child’s



character and thinking. “I keep teaching my children that this is how liberty is preserved in our society,” she said. “I want them to understand these principles so that our grandchildren will also live in liberty.”

After completing the Principle Approach Master Teacher Certification Program, Kim joined the FACE teaching faculty. “It is a rich experience to teach teachers,” she reflected. “As I teach, my own understanding becomes clearer. I’m still learning.”

Kim also sees the long-term impact of this work. “Each teacher who learns these principles influences many students. By God’s grace, if I can plant a seed that grows and produces fruit, I may never see the harvest—but many others will be taught.”

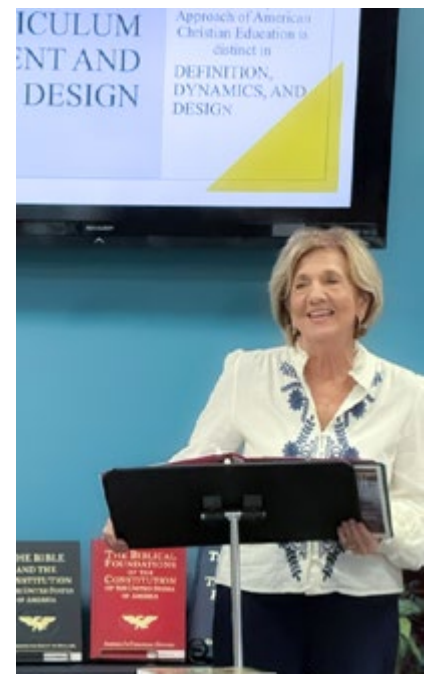
